

Grandview Neighborhood Parking Permits

Middletown Borough Council approved a permit parking system for the Grandview Neighborhood. The system will be installed over the summer and will be in effect for the return of students to the Penn State Harrisburg campus.

According to the local law adopted by Council, the purpose of this system is to properly distribute limited on-street parking resources between the competing needs of different populations including students, faculty, and staff of Penn State University Harrisburg, the residents and visitors of the Grandview Neighborhood, and others. The goal is to develop a fair and legally enforceable system.

1. Blocks with unlimited parking (no placard needed):
 - a. The north side of Wharton Avenue from Penn State University to N. Catherine Street.
 - b. The south side of Wharton Avenue from Penn State University to N. Spring Street.
 - c. The north side of Grandview Avenue from N. Catherine Street to N. Union Street.
 - d. The west side of N. Catherine Street from Grandview Avenue to Wharton Avenue.
2. Blocks requiring a resident parking placard:
 - a. The north side of Wharton Avenue from N. Catherine Street to N. Union Street.
 - b. The south side of Wharton Avenue from N. Spring Street to N. Union Street
 - c. The north side of W. Roosevelt Avenue from N. Catherine Street to N. Union Street.
 - d. The south side of W. Roosevelt Avenue from N. Catherine Street to N. Union Street.
 - e. The south side of Grandview Avenue from N. Catherine Street to N. Union Street.
 - f. The east side of N. Catherine Street from Grandview Avenue to Wharton Avenue.
 - g. The west side of N. Spring Street from Grandview Avenue to the Middletown Cemetery.
 - h. The east side of N. Spring Street from Grandview Avenue to the Middletown Cemetery.

3. Residential street addresses that will receive no-cost resident parking placards:
 - a. Grandview Avenue: 28, 32, 38, 44, 104, 118, 124
 - b. N. Spring Street: 737, 803, 916, 920
 - c. N. Union Street: 729, 735, 809, 817, 915
 - d. W. Roosevelt Avenue: 26, 27, 31, 32, 35, 39, 40, 42, 45, 46, 49, 50, 53, 54, 57, 60, 101, 108, 109, 112, 115, 116, 119, 120, 124, 125
 - e. Wharton Avenue: 11, 27, 28, 34, 37, 38, 40, 43, 46, 47, 51, 53, 54, 111, 117, 123, 127
4. The quantity of placards given per street address: three (3) placards per address to be used as needed on unlimited vehicles without restriction.
5. Placards must be clearly displayed on the dashboard of each vehicle parked on-street and placed between the steering wheel and front windshield. Failure to properly display a parking placard may result in citation for illegal parking. Boat trailers, recreation vehicles, and other miscellaneous vehicles require Penn DOT registration and a placard to be parked on-street.
6. Placards are transferrable between vehicles and are the responsibility of the aforementioned property owners. Property owners may lend their parking placards to visitors or service vehicles that require on-street parking. A fee may be charged for lost or damaged placards.
7. Placards will be individually numbered and the Middletown Communications Center will maintain a list to match each parking pass to a corresponding property street address.
8. A limited number of resident parking placards will be made available to residents in other neighborhoods of Middletown. A resident of another neighborhood who wishes to obtain a parking pass must make application to the Borough Manager; provide proof of residency, and explanation of need to park in the Grandview Neighborhood. No fee will be charged for applications granted.
9. Non-residents and those residents who do not have a parking placard can park without restriction on blocks designated in Section 1 above.
10. The cost of creating the parking placards and establishing the database is being generously donated to the Borough by Penn State.
11. The Middletown Police will patrol the neighborhood and confirm the placement of parking placards on each vehicle parked on-street. Vehicles without a valid parking pass may receive a parking citation. You can call the Police at 948-3000 if you notice a vehicle parked without a placard.
12. For parties or other special circumstances, call the Middletown Police for temporary permission to park at 948-3000.
